### **CROSSING GUARD**

Crossing Guards are non-sworn, part-time employees of the Palos Hills Police Department. Crossing Guards assist students crossing major intersections by ensuring both students' and motorists' adherence to traffic signal directions.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Must have High School Diploma or GED equivalent.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must be of good moral character and of temperament.
- Must have basic knowledge of traffic laws.
- Must provide enough information for a thorough background check and pass a background investigation.
- Must be in good physical condition.
- Must have the ability to work in all types of weather conditions.
- Must be able to supervise large groups of students and direct traffic.

#### **Notice**

- This position is for part-time crossing guard with approximately 5 hours of work a week.
- The work schedule will involve approximately 30 minutes in the morning and 30 minutes in the afternoon (Monday – Friday) on school days when children are present.
- The current pay rate for a Crossing Guard is \$24.80 per hour.
